Text of Speech of H. E. Mehran Movahed Far, Hon'ble Consul General of I. R. Iran in Lahore on the 45th Anniversary of the Glorious Islamic Revolution & Iran National Day, 12 February 2024

In the past 4 months, we are witness to a real and unprecedented holocaust in Gaza & Palestine. Collective punishment, forced displacement and genocide by the occupying and apartheid Zionist Regime is a policy which this regime has been pursuing in the past 75 years; however, it has manifested horrifying spectacles in the past 4 months.

Regardless of any factors like ethnicity, language or religion, Palestine is an issue of human value and the world today is faced with systematic violation of the natural and fundamental rights of the Palestinian nation. While the absolute failure of the so-called two-state solution has become clear after 35 years, the Islamic Republic of Iran believes that the only solution to overcome the Palestine crisis is holding a referendum at the participation of all original inhabitants of Palestine including Muslims, Christians and the Jews. This is the only democratic and peaceful solution to end this 75-year tragedy.

I wish peace and welfare for the government and people of Pakistan and the Islamic Ummah and once again I express my thanks to all our dear guests.
