Iran

Iran is a country in West Asia that is also referred to as Persia and formally recognized as the Islamic Republic of Iran. It shares borders with Turkmenistan and the Caspian Sea to the north, Afghanistan to the east, Pakistan to the southeast, the Gulf of Oman and the Persian Gulf to the south, Iraq to the west and Turkey, Armenia and Azerbaijan to the northwest. It is the 17th largest country in the world, with a total size of 1.648 million square kilometers. It is the fourth-largest country in the entire Asia and the second-largest country in West Asia after Saudi Arabia. Iran is also the 17th most populous country in the world, home to almost 90 million people.

Iranian plateau

Iran's earliest known archeological artifacts testifies to the existence of humans there dating back to the Lower Paleolithic. The Iranian Plateau is home to dozens of prehistoric sites that indicate the presence of ancient cultures and urban communities dating back to the fourth millennium B.C.

The nation's 27 UNESCO World Heritage Sites are a testament to its rich cultural history. In terms of Intangible Cultural Heritage, Iran is ranked fifth in the world.

Iran has a key position in the Asia Continent. It is a founding member of the United Nations, the ECO, the OIC, the OPEC, and a member of BRICS, and ACD.

Iran's economy is distinguished not just by its hydrocarbon, industrial, agricultural, and service sectors, it is recognized as an "energy rich", since it holds 10% of the world's proven oil reserves and 15% of its confirmed gas reserves and has leading manufacturing industries in different fields such as construction materials, automobile manufacture, transportation, food and agricultural goods, home appliances, information technology, and petrochemicals. It has also a developed nanotechnology, biotechnology, and pharmaceutical industry.

Economic diversity, scientific education, growing consumer class, population with high urbanization rate, entrepreneurial culture, and strategic geographical location are considered as the strong points of the Iranian market from the perspective of McKinsey Global Institute.

Isfahan Province

Isfahan Province covers an area of around 107,018 Square Kilometer and is the 3rd largest province among Iran's 31 provinces. The provincial capital, Isfahan, is situated in the center of the country, at the junction of the two main road networks that cross north-south and east-west of Iran.

The golden era of Isfahan was from the 9th to the 18th century, when Isfahan was made the capital of Persia for the third time during the Safavid dynasty, where much of its history is well maintained. The city is well-known for its historical monuments including the covered bridges, magnificent boulevards, tiled mosques, minarets, artworks, and Perso-Islamic architecture. The city is recalled as "Isfahan Nesfe- Jahan" – "Isfahan half the world". Naqsh-e Jahan Square, one of the biggest city squares in the world, is recognized by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site.

Isfahan province is known as the second industrial region of the country with about 9000 active industrial units. Isfahan Mobarakeh Steel Complex is the largest producer of steel in the Middle East and North Africa. Also, the most advanced aircraft manufacturing factory in Iran, is located in the Isfahan. Isfahan Oil Refining Company is another major industry, operating since 1979, producing almost 23% of the country's petroleum products.

The biggest and the best-equipped Science and Technology park of Iran, hosting over 700 knowledge-based enterprises, is located in Isfahan.

The province of Isfahan also holds a prominent status on the global stage as an investment destination, thanks to its abundant mineral resources, expansive domestic and regional market, strategic regional position, attractive business environment, and energy security.

The economic and business structure of the province for exports and imports of goods, stands out in the country. The most important export commodities are ferrous metals, steel, mineral products, organic chemical, plastics and rubber, carpets, dairy products, fruits and vegetables, and auto parts. The most significant imported items include iron alloys (ferroalloys), carbon electrodes, spinning machines, electronic equipment, machinery, synthetic fibers, electric motors and generators, compressors and pumps, unprocessed aluminum and raw gold.

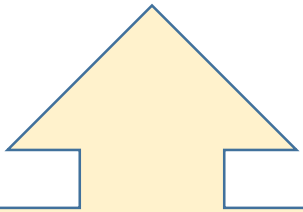

Isfahan is famous for its Islamic architecture, with many beautiful boulevards, covered bridges, palaces, mosques, and minarets. The historical background of the city and variety of historic monuments attract large number of foreign tourists and visitors to Isfahan annually. In the last 8 month 321,956 foreign and 615,046 national tourists have visited Isfahan. With over 2000 natural attraction sites, 1760 national registered sites, 6 internationally registered sites, Isfahan is one of the ten most beautiful cities in the world in terms of tourism. Besides the attraction sites, the city is famous for its artists and their handicrafts and artworks that attract visitors. The handmade carpets of Isfahan have a world class reputation which is the indicative of originality and nobility of Iranian products.

There are also 287 kinds of handicrafts products in Isfahan which ranked the province as the second in the world.

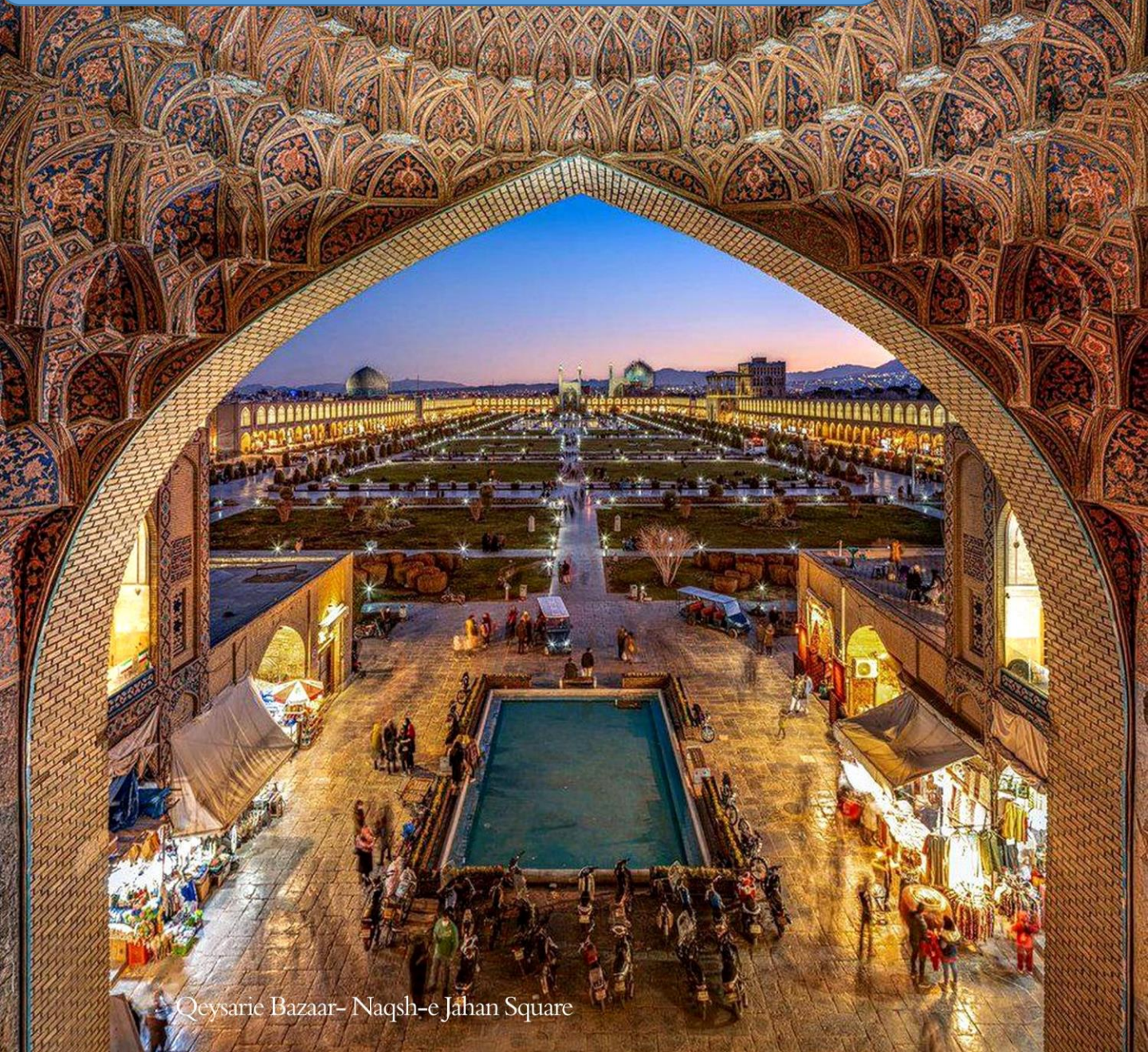
